**What to Bring:**

**Sleeping gear:**

**Girls:** Girls will be staying in dorm style building with bunk beds. Sleeping bag, pillow, sheet (optional)

**Boys:** Boys will be camping in their own tents. Sleeping bag, pillow, sleeping mat, tent

(Coming with friends? You can share a tent. Don't have a tent? Call us and we'll see if we can arrange something)

**Personal Hygiene items:**

Toothbrush/toothpaste, shampoo, soap, towel, wash cloth etc.

**Rodeo Gear:**

Saddle/bareback rigging, ropes, bull ropes, boots, bandages, spurs, lucky shirt, etc.

**Protective gear:**

Vest, helmet, mouth guard, etc.

**Horse care:**

If bringing your own horse: hay/grain, buckets, riding tack/grooming supplies. Please contact us to arrange a pen. Water buckets and hose access are available. **Current Coggins test required**

**General:**

Bible, notebook, pen/pencil, camera, shoes and clothes suitable for outdoor activities, rain coat.

If joining the Jack Pot rodeo bring some nice western wear. (\$5 entry fee if you want to win something)

\*For parents who are planning to camp at RBC, please call us with number of people and type of camping (tent, RV, Trailer etc.) and if you will be joining us for meals before May 30<sup>th</sup>. Suggested donation of \$50 for all meals.
